BUILDING THE EDUCATION STATE

The Andrews Labor Government is getting on with delivering schools and upgrades Victorian students and teachers rely on.

Member for Sunbury Josh Bull announced \$13.4 million for Diggers Rest Primary School today to transform, upgrade, and modernise the school.
